

Predicting toxicities in melanoma patients treated with immunotherapy

Toxicities can occur in up to 55% of melanoma patients treated with immunotherapy:







Progress:

Pilot study used the detection of autoantibodies to predict the onset of these toxicities before clinical detection

Findings currently being validated in a large melanoma patient cohort



Future Implications for Patients:

Measuring autoantibodies may identify patients at risk of developing or detect the early onset of treatment toxicity
